# CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINE

## CHAMPAGNE

### **Irroy Extra Brut, Champagne NV | £59.00**

Aromatic, rich and fruity with a deliciously crisp palate. The Extra Brut NV, is an elegant yet characterful Champagne, with a lightness of touch that makes it a perfect aperitif or party tippie. It is a blend of 30% Chardonnay (finesse and elegance), 70% Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier (structure, richness, fruitiness and a smooth mouthfeel), and is aged for a minimum of two and a half years before release.

### **Pol Roger Brut | £98.00**

Pol Roger may be one of the smallest of the 'Grand Marque' Champagne Houses but it is one of the very finest. A mineral and complex nose of soft lemon and white blossom; a crisp and lively palate with a creamy texture from the mousse and a long, clean finish.

### **Bollinger Special Cuvée NV | £106.00**

The blend consists of 60% Pinot Noir, 25% Chardonnay and 15% Pinot Meunier, all harvested from 30 different Crus in Champagne, with the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes coming exclusively from Grand and Premiers Crus. Bollinger Special Cuvée is aged for a minimum of 3 years before disgorgement.

### **Laurent Perrier Cuvée Brut Rose NV | £98.00**

A supreme classic. 100% Pinot Noir gives a dominant fruit flavour, outstanding.

## SPARKLING WINE

### **Domaine Kientzler, Cremant d'Alsace Brut | £38.00**

Crafted from 100% Auxerrois grapes, the Domaine Kientzler Cremant d'Alsace is a light straw colour, with notes of lime, lemon peel and apricot flesh. It's juicy and mouthwatering with persistent bubbles and long length. This feels a bit more elegant and refined than some, everything balanced and harmonious with a lovely lingering lemon brioche note at the end

# WHITE WINE

## **Chemin de la Serre, 2023 Marsanne-Viognier, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France | £34.00**

The Languedoc is home of some of the most unbeatable viognier wines to be found these days and Chemin de la Serre is a great example of what the region has to offer. Finest flavours of white peach and apricot with hints of flowers and spice and a refreshing acidity.

## **Belardent Picpoul de Pinet 2023, Languedoc, France | £36.00**

The vineyard is located on the edge of the Thau Lagoon which is one of the oldest wine growing areas in the Mediterranean. Clean and crisp palate displaying white flowers and white peaches. Very refreshing.

## **S.A. Prum Solitar Riesling 2023 | £38.00**

Founded in 1610 the Jean Becker estate is one of the seven oldest families in the Alsace region, now run by the 13th generation. It is certified Organic. This Riesling is dry and racy with delicate fruits and floral hints and some minerality. This wine is organic and will pair well with fish, seafood and white meats.

## **Atance Cuvee No.1, Valencia 2024, Spain | £34.00**

Brilliant, limpid and straw yellow in colour. Predominant aromas of white flower with notes of tropical fruit. Initially bold, with a balanced acidity and a long-lasting taste. Amazing value for money, this wine has serious quality.

## **Mâcon Villages Domaine Chene Burgundy, France 2022 | £36.00**

Stunning tropical fruits and green apple on the nose. The palate is bursting with fresh citrus and tropical fruits, melons and a slight hint of chalk on the finish.

## **Elgin Valley, La Brune, The Valley Chardonnay 2023 | £38.00**

La Brune (French for 'Brunette') was created when multi-award winning winemaker, Nico Grobler, responsible for Eikendal wines of Stellenbosch, visited Burgundy and fell in love with Burgundian winemaking and the expression of their wines. Bringing this back to South African soil, his wines focus on finesse, elegance and purity of fruit.

## **Sancerre Domaine Millet Roger Loire Valley, France 2023 | £52.00**

The Domaine lies in the heart of the region at Bué, one of the very best of the Sancerre villages, on limestone/ clay soil which gives the wine all the ripe, exhilaratingly gooseberry flavours that you could ask for.

## **Pouilly Fumé La Mariée 2022 | £46.00**

Aromatic and floral with intricate zesty fruits on the palate and a dry flinty finish.

## **Pouilly Fuissé aux Chailloux, France 2022 | £52.00**

Matured for 10 months on lees gives this Chardonnay a bright golden colour. Combining incredible aromas of ginger and delicate wood with intense notes of nuts, honeyed fruit and a delicate yet well-structured mineral finish.

# RED WINE

## **Chemin de la Serre Carignan Vieilles Vignes 2023, Pays d'Herault, France | £36.00**

Made from old vines of Carignan, a traditional grape variety from the South of France. This deep red shows delightful aromas of cherry and blackcurrant with spicy hints of cloves and vanilla.

## **Las Pampas Malbec 2023, Argentina | £36.00**

Very intense purplish red in colour. Complex on the nose with a combination of red fruits such as cherries and a hint of violets. The palate is smooth with a velvety mouth feel, this is a fresh and fruity wine that carries blackcurrant, black cherry, plum and violet.

## **Armigero Sangiovese di Romagna DOC 2019, Italy | £36.00**

Notes of dried fruits and spices. Warm, soft and full bodied with a long-lasting finish of ripe blackberries. Great match with hard cheeses and red meats.

## **Atance Bobal, Valencia 2022, Spain | £34.00**

A medium-bodied red wine with aromas of red berries, plum and a hint of spice. The palate offers flavours of ripe red fruit, subtle earthiness and a touch of pepper, supported by smooth tannins and balanced acidity.

## **Côtes du Rhône, Vieilles Vignes, 2022, Les Coteaux du Rhône, France | £38.00**

Sourced around the medieval village of Serignan du Comtat, produce traditional Rhône wine with character. Easy drinking with lots of fresh cherry and strawberry fruit flavours and fine tannins.

## **Barbera d'Alba Superiore San Pancrazio, Pelessa 2021, Italy | £46.00**

After a malolactic fermentation the wine is matured in French and Slavonian wooden casks for 12 months before another 12 months in bottle. Fragrant bouquet with ripe berry fruit and vanilla notes. Full bodied with a smooth palate and a good concentration of flavours.

## **Château Lanessan 2019, Cru Bourgeois, Haut-Medoc, Bordeaux, France | £48.00**

This property is only classified as Cru Bourgeois as the family didn't think submitting the wine for the 1855 classification would add anything to its already stellar reputation. A very well-balanced wine with good concentration of dark brambly berries, smokey notes and hints of bay leaves and earthiness on the palate.

## **Reserve d'Angludet 2020 Margaux, Medoc, Bordeaux, France | £82.00**

Owned since 1961 by the Sichel family, who part own Chateau Palmer and a number of other estates. With sweet cassis fruit intermixed with liquorice, truffles, and earthy notes. Very ripe and fresh with supple tannin and explosive fruit richness.

## ROSÉ WINE

### St Sidoine Rosé, 2023 France | £40.00

St Sidoine specialises in fine, focused Provence rosés with an emphasis on delicate, elegant fruit and minerality.

## PORT

### Graham's LBV 2017 | £58.00

Glorious dark red in colour with aromas of redcurrants, raspberry and cranberry. The palate is full of rich ripe cherries and hints of mocha. Perfect with cheese or chocolate desserts.

### Quinta da Silveira 10 year tawny | £82.00

This delicious Tawny port is crafted from tawny casks up to 70 years in age, showing a seductive nose of mixed nuts and dried fruit. It is beautifully rounded on the palate with a long elegant finish.

### Graham's 1997 Vintage Port | £120.00

Plum and blackberry on the nose, with hints of dried violets. Wet earth. Full-bodied, medium-sweet, very chewy and rich. Long and caressing. Very layered and structured.

## DESSERT WINE

### Château Doisy Védrières 2018 (37.5 cl), Sauternes, France | £38.00

Luscious with honey notes and quince aromas. Beautifully sweet with a refreshing acidity, it has some complexity and a great length.

### Ochoa Moscatel Vendimia Tardía 2022, Navarra, Spain (50cl) | £42.00

Great aromaticity with notes of honey, toasted bread, raisins and orange blossom. It is well balanced with a silky texture.

### Chateau Rieussec, Carmes de Rieussec 2020, France (37.5 cl) | £42.00

Sauternes are some of the longest lived wines with premium examples from exceptional vintages having the potential to last 100 years or more. They are characterised by their balance of sweetness and zest of acidity with typical notes of apricots, honey, peaches with a nutty edge.

A Minneapolis special, made with vodka, triple sec, cranberry juice. The Cosmopolitan is known for its vibrant colour and crisp, citrus-forward flavour, offering a balance of sweet, sour, and slightly bitter notes.

## Spicy Margarita

A bold twist on the classic margarita. Made with tequila, lime and jalapeño. Served over ice with a salted rim, it's flavoursome with a hint of heat.

## Whisky Sour

A classic cocktail made with whiskey, lemon juice, and egg white. The smooth richness of Whiskey with the tartness of lemon juice and the sweetness of simple syrup, creates a deliciously, well-balanced beverage.

## Bramble

Made with gin, lemon juice, sugar syrup, and blackberry liqueur. Served over ice and garnished with fresh blackberries, giving this beverage a sharp flavour with a hint of berry richness.

## Old Fashioned

A timeless cocktail made with whiskey, a few dashes of bitters, and a splash of water. It's stirred with ice and garnished with orange peel. Simple, smooth, and rich in flavour.

## Negroni

A bold cocktail made with gin, sweet vermouth, and Campari. The result is a dry and bitter cocktail with an intriguing depth of aromatic flavours.
